Forerunner of the Thrift Sale....the vision continues.

The Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Thrift Sale is actively seeking a Sale Manager. The following job posting will be posted to the general public later this week. This information is for our members and volunteers with the hope that you may know a qualified candidate or have a personal interest.

Part-time Manager for established Ann Arbor non-profit Thrift Sale operating with both limited paid staffing and significant volunteer help. Current operations include two locations with a weekly one day sale and two half days for preparation and display of merchandise. Saturday work availability is a requirement. Manager will be accountable to an oversight committee and have responsibility to modify and develop existing operations to achieve revenue growth, improve internal communications, and create a plan with agreed upon metrics related to revenue, inventory quality, expenses, and asset allocation. Prior retail management experience, excellent communication skills, and decision making ability are critical factors. Physical ability to handle merchandise and other physical tasks are desirable. Initially the compensation is related to an expectation of 20-30 hours per week and plans that the position will grow to full time within 2 years.

Applicants should submit a resume that includes specific retail management experience and educational background. If accepted for interview, at least two references will be required, and if considered for the position a criminal background check will be necessary.
